Learning from Belarus, Russia and Japan's BRs

Since 1970, UNESCO Biosphere Reserves (BR) were designated as the model regions for the sustainable development, and provides the learning site for the successful implementation of the UN's 2030 Agenda, to achieve 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). However, implementation of the SDGs into the BRs requires multidisciplinary and cross-cutting approaches and involvement of the academic institutions would be very import for their successful achievements. Well-defined and agreed educational mechanism should be implemented by academic institutions together with the local stakeholders inside the BRs.

Kanazawa University, jointly with UNESCO Mount Hakusan Biosphere Reserve Committee United Nations University Institute for the Advanced Study of Sustainability Operating Unit Ishikawa/Kanazawa and local NPO's has organized the multi-stakeholders forum to develop the educational platform that combines academic knowledge of environmental sciences, local communities, and the experiences of the international communities. In this Forum, to contribute for the successful implementation of the SDGs in Eurasia region (Belarus, Russia and Japan) we are going to create the platform to share the educational experiences conducted in each country, and develop international collaborative work.
